**Dr Seema** is an **Associate Professor** at the Centre for Psychology, School of Medical Sciences, University of Hyderabad, one of the premier Central Universities in India. Her core teaching areas include Developmental Psychology, Social Psychology, and Sports Psychology. She is a recipient of the University of Hyderabad Chancellor's Award 2025 for her contribution to teaching and research. Moreover, she has been involved in content development and the creation of visual aids for e-learning for the University Grants Commission-Consortium for Education Communication (UGC-CEC). She has also launched a program under MOOCS—a flagship program of the Government of India.
